BSC has placed in the top 5 in several years it has competed for the past 30 years, and has advanced to International Competition three times. BSC does other performances throughout the year, as well, such as a major annual show, which will be in December this year. We have also performed on WGBH's Sing that Thing! We even sang the national anthem at Fenway Park in the past.
